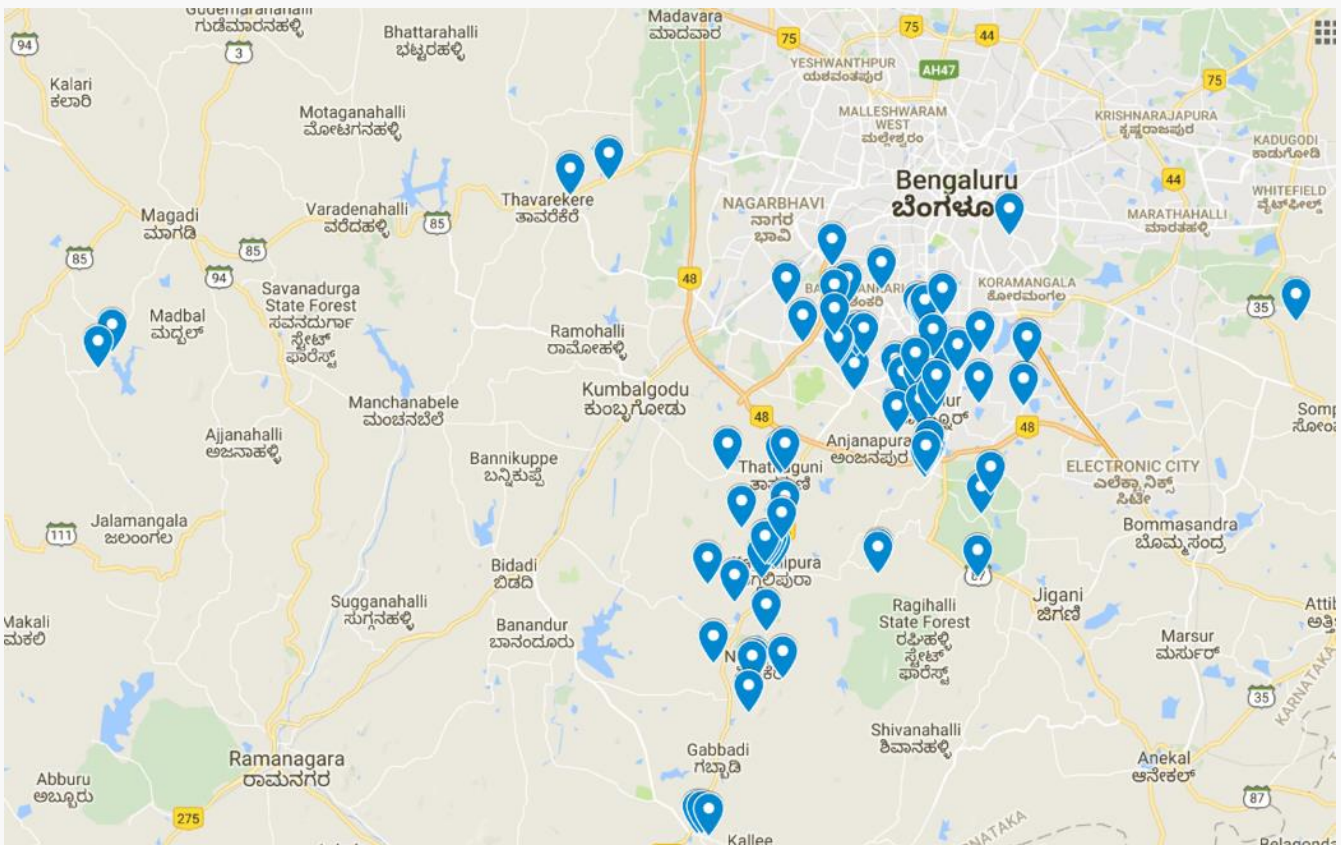
Abhyudaya has a total of 86 centres located throughout Bengaluru South.

Free classes helped poor students rise to top

Bengaluru: With the aim of reducing dropout rates of students from lower income groups, Abhyudaya, a city based not-for-profit organisation conducted 110 days of special classes for over 250 SSLC students. The classes were held in different parts of the city and more than 60 students who sat for these classes have scored a minimum 85%. Children of weavers, painters, drivers and vegetable vendors were regulars to class.

"I was scared of maths, science and English grammar," said Varshitha HP from Carmel Public School who secured 89%. "The classes helped me overcome my fear and focus better," said Varshitha, whose father is an autorickshaw driver.

Sneha A of Kasturba High School, who scored 86%, credits her success to the free classes she attended for a month. Sneha wants to become an engineer. Meenakshi S Katkar from Carmel Public School secured 94%. Her father Shankar V is a painter. She joined the coaching classes in November 2018 and has keen interest in agricultural sciences.

"Besides regular classes in school, studying for two

hours daily at coaching classes were helpful in preparing for the exam," says Pooja BM, who secured 87%. A kho-kho player, she studied at St Glorious Convent and wants to become a dentist.

DR Vidyashankar, member of the advisory board, Abhyudaya, said classes were held from November to February after school hours. On Sundays, students also got to interact with experts from various fields.

AUTO DRIVER'S DAUGHTER SCORES HIGH

Poverty at home was no deterrent for this girl who scored a centum in four subjects. **Ashwini K Rao** from JP Nagar, an autorickshaw driver's daughter, scored 601/625 and aims to join the civil services.

Ashwini scored a centum in Kannada, Hindi, maths and social science. However, she was upset as she got 82 in science — below expectations — and

wants to apply for revaluation. Discussion Class Association, a city-based

organisation had provided Ashwini with a scholarship in recognition of her excellent performance in academics. "My father, who works as an

auto driver and my mother who is a housewife have toiled really hard for my education," she said. She plans to pursue BSc Agriculture. TNN




"Every Sunday, we used to have one guest speaker who would address students on how to dream big and work hard to achieve their dreams," Vidyashankar said. "Some of our guests were IPS officers, well known psychologists and

entrepreneurs who interacted with students. These exposures helped students."

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When Deprived Children from Bengaluru slums Collected Funds for Flood Relief in Karnataka and Kerala

The recent floods in Kodagu (Karnataka) and Kerala brought many people across the country together. It is common to see that during distress people unite and help each other. But if people who are affected by the deprivations themselves come out to help others who are affected by the disaster, then it should be appreciated.

The above case of fine generosity was witnessed at Abhyudaya, a Bengaluru based free learning centres for the deprived children from slum areas. Children from 83 centres of Abhyudaya collected Rs 67, 000 from their neighbourhoods for the flood relief. They collected the amount from the same localities where they live. Small vegetable vendors, petty shops, small workshops who are the acquaintance of these children contributed a small amount from one to ten rupees.

More than the amount collected by the children their door to door campaign created a lot of awareness among the masses. Many adults got inspired by this act of the children. It is also a lesson for the leaders and the Government not to depend on any foreign aid. Bharat is a very big country and contribution from every individual can fund relief for any number of crises. Helping each other will unite people and in turn boost national integration. Children carried out placards with them with slogans on flood relief for Kerala and Kodagu. More than ten thousand houses contributed to the relief fund.

Abhyudaya Steered the Drive

Abhyudaya has more than 83 free learning centres in Bengaluru located mostly in lower income group settlements. Each centre has a volunteer teacher who is a college-going student from the same neighbourhood and coming from a lower income background.

Most of the children come from deprived backgrounds. Their parents work as labourers in unorganised sectors earning a very small amount of money. Mothers usually work as housemaids. But parents did not deny contribution when their children raised funds for flood relief. Some of them who contributed to the funds were roadside flower vendors, fruit vendors, hawkers, small tailors.

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

Vidyanidhi Scholarships to Deprived Students

Bengaluru: Abhyudaya Vidyanidhi, a scholarship programme for deserving students from the deprived sections of the society, has benefited thousands. This year the event to distribute the scholarship was held on July 7.

In a new record this year, the scholarships worth Rs 2.5 million were distributed for 150 socially deprived students from the disadvantaged section of the society. The chief guest for the event was MD of Ace Manufacturing Systems Ltd Shri P Ramadas. General Manager of Suprajit Industries Shri Narahari presided over the function. More than 300 children and their parents were present. The event was organised at Annapoomeshwari Kalyana Mantapa.

Shri Ramadas spoke about the importance of achievement in life, determination and education. He informed that he would try his best to support Abhyudaya and its mission. He asked the students to never give up. His own life story is an example to this. Shri Ramdas was one of the

pioneers in the country who started computer-based design. He started Ace Manufacturing in a small garage in 1994 to manufacture CNC Machine tools. Two decades later, the company is spread over 20 acres today. His company manufactures more than a few thousand machines every year and till now they have manufactured 35000 plus machines. Lakhs of people have got the guidance for their livelihood by Shri Ramdas because of his CNC machines. He also saved thousand of crore of foreign exchange by being part of Make in India in the field of CNC machines.

Shri Manjunath, GM of an IT firm and an advisor for Abhyudaya, gave an example of a girl whose mother was a housemaid and her in-laws were also very poor. Her father-in-law used work as a daily wage labourer in the city market. The entire family was uneducated. However, the girl who was determined was supported by Abhyudaya. She studied hard at an evening college and did her B.Com and then did ICWAI. Today, she works in a top IT company. He gave another example of a newspaper vendor boy, Satish, who with his determination came up in life and is doing well for himself. He gave many examples of how by hard work and with support of Abhyudaya many people are now leading a better life. Later, Shri Manjunath also narrated the journey of Abhyudaya, which has grown from supporting 12 children in 2004 to 3600 children in 2019. Abhyudaya teaches culture and moral values also along with education, he said.

The scholarship event began with remembering Shri Nagabushan, a great philanthropist who passed away last month. He had donated the land on which Abhyudaya building at Konanakunte stands today. Shri Nagabushan was an inspiration to many and his philanthropic activities were well known.

Verification for Scholarship

Identifying beneficiaries for the scholarship is not a mean task. It is an effort of many volunteers and the organisations to select the most deserving and rightful recipients. For the last few months, Abhyudaya volunteers visited more than a hundred houses located in very low-income group areas to do the required background verification. They had to also check if the applicants for Vidyanidhi scholarship are really needy and had to verify their economic status.

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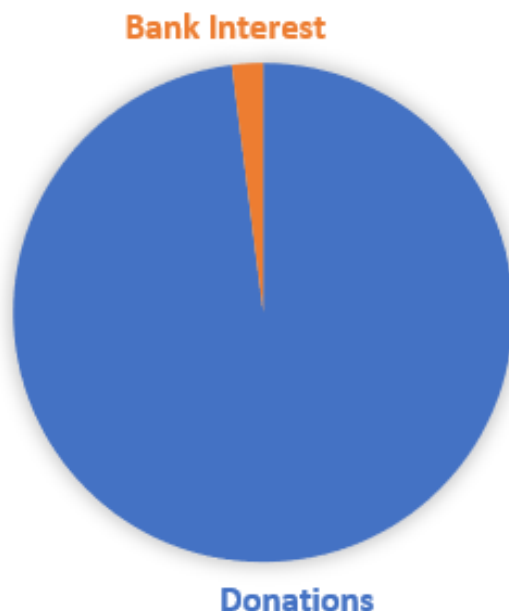
